

## **DIRECTIONS FOR IRWELL PLACE PARKING (map on overleaf)**

We recommend parking at Irwell Place Car Park (postcode M5 4PE), which is located on the other side of the A6/Salford Crescent.

### **How to get to Irwell Place Car Park:**

Driving eastbound on the A6 –

- Take the right turn lane parallel to the large red ‘Ambition’ sign down Irwell Place Road.
- Drive straight down the road and you will reach the Irwell Place Car Park ahead of you (M5 4PE).

Driving westbound on the A6 –

- Pass Humphrey Booth House and Crescent House on your left, then take the next left hand turn onto Irwell Place Road. This road is directly opposite the large red ‘Ambition’ sign.
- Drive straight down the road and you will reach the Irwell Place Car Park ahead of you (M5 4PE).

### **How to walk from Irwell Place Car Park to the New Adelphi Theatre:**

- Walking distance from Irwell Place Car Park to the New Adelphi Building is 7 minutes/0.3 miles.
- Exit the car park and walk along Irwell Place until you reach the main, four-lane road (A6/The Crescent).
- Cross the road using the pedestrian crossing with traffic island.
- Turn left and walk towards the main campus.

- Pass the large red 'Ambition' sign and continue walking past the Peel building. Bear right down the slope (University Road).
- You will be able to see New Adelphi (the large grey building) ahead of you to the right.
- When you reach the roundabout at the bottom of University Road, bear right to head towards New Adelphi, until you are standing in front of the covered area.
- Turn right and walk towards the main entrance, which you will find halfway along the building.

### Paying for Parking:

Parking is chargeable 7 days a week between the hours of 9am to 6pm. After 6pm, all parking on campus is free. Please note: all university car parks use the PayByPhone App. Irwell Place also has a Pay and Display machine.

## [DIRECTIONS FOR BLUE BADGE PARKING \(map on overleaf\)](#)

Our closest Blue Badge parking can be found at – our Newton/Peel car park:

### **How to get to Newton/Peel Car Park:**

- Driving eastbound on the A6, turn left before the Maxwell Building (M5 4WT) at the barrier.
- Drive straight down the path past the statue, towards The Salford Museum and Art Gallery (M4 4WU).
- There is a road to the right of the Salford Museum and Art Gallery and to the left of Maxwell Building, which has another barrier. Blue Badge parkers will be permitted to enter through this barrier.
- Follow the one-way road curving behind The Salford Museum and Art Gallery, with the Museum on your left and the park on your right and you will find the Blue Badge parking spots available in the car parks labelled in the attached map.

### **How to get to the New Adelphi Theatre:**

- Once parked, head towards the main campus area with our Newton building on your left, our Cockcroft Building/Energy House on your right, and you will see our New Adelphi Building on your left-hand-side.

### **How to exit the Newton/Peel Car Park:**

- Follow the one-way route out of the car park, curving round past the Newton Building on your right, the red-brick Peel Building on your left.
- Follow the road until you reach the roundabout, where you can:

- Take the first exit to University Road past Salford Crescent Train Station to get back onto the A6 Eastbound
- Take the second exit to University Road West to get back onto the A6 Westbound
- Take the third exit to continue down campus, leading to Wallness Lane.

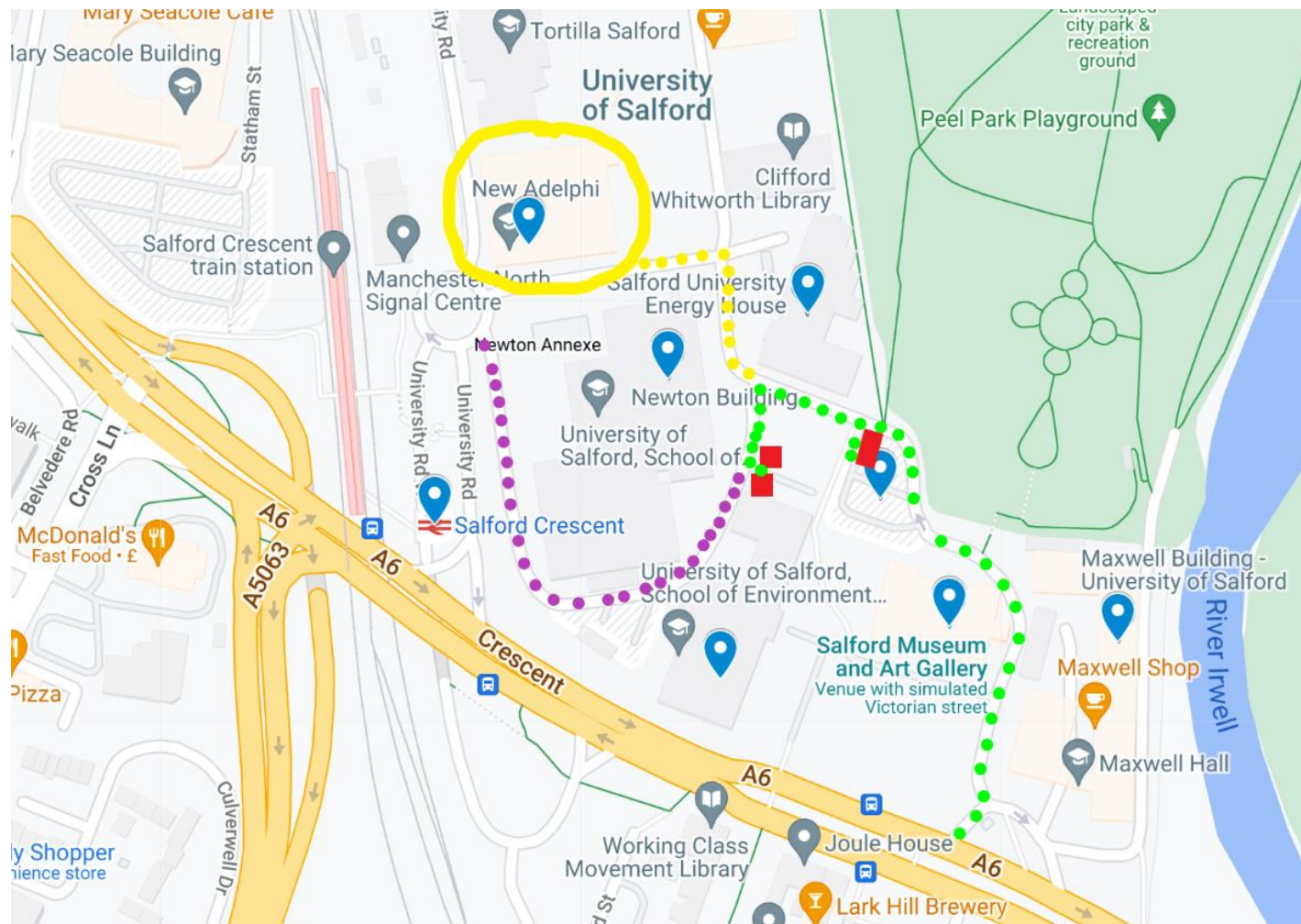
Driving entry to Car Park – GREEN ROUTE
